Ecosystem Services Valuation Database (ESVD)

The ESVD is the largest publicly available database with standardized monetary values for all ecosystem services and all biomes on all continents. It aims to provide a comprehensive, trustworthy, up-to-date and easily accessible database with state-of-the-art information on the monetary value of all ecosystem services. Ultimately, our goal with the ESVD is to contribute to averting biodiversity loss and ecosystem degradation as well as bringing ecosystem services into decision-making, to be used in research and in policy-making. ESVD

The ESVD has seen major updates in recent years, showing the great demand for our work. Your main tasks include assisting with the growth and quality of the ESVD. Concretely, this consists of adding data, finding studies and validating output. ESP

We are currently preparing for the 6th European ESP Conference, which will take place in May 2026 in Prague. As an intern, you will support our team with the conference organisation. Your main tasks will include preparing important conference materials, communication with delegates, updating the conference website, managing the digital event platform and other related tasks. Since this conference is in the initial stages of preparation, you will be able to observe and contribute to the shaping of the overall conference format and program.
